1. Do the regions of Global Campus have safety plans in place?  
There are region level guidelines for reporting and escalating security issues as part of site and region emergency action plans.
2. Are the facilities and grounds in the regions regularly reviewed and/or tested for health and safety concerns?  
Yes, annually.
3. How does the institution ensure campus security at all its regional sites?  
Each site maintains an emergency action plan.
4. How is the issue of security handled at our Global Campus locations?  
Sites on military installations and are covered by the installation's security procedures. Security is provided in certain multi-tenant locations. Smaller or standalone sites rely on local public safety to provide security and safety support.
5. Are copies available of current regional safety, emergency and disaster plans (if different from the general safety plan in the first bullet above)?  
Emergency action plans are available at each site's web site or may be requested directly from the site or the region office.
6. Are copies of health inspection reports available for the regional sites?  
No site provides food services or residence facilities.
7. What kind of evidence exists that the regional sites are in compliance with environmental and occupational regulations?  
All leased facilities are in compliance with the terms of their respective leases as approved by the University and the facilities meet the requirements of local building and safety codes. These are reviewed each time a lease is renewed.
8. Do all of the regional buildings have evacuation plans posted?  
Yes.
