Catalog 2007-2008 for the RN to BSN/MSN Track.

At the October 10, 2006 BSN Faculty Meeting, BSN faculty voted to approve updating the course description for two courses in the BSN Clinical Nursing Sequence of the RN to BSN/MSN track, which include NSG 4430, Advanced Nursing Theory and NSG 4431, Advanced Nursing Preceptorship. Please forward these updates as appropriate. Thank you.

 The current course descriptions from the Troy University, Undergraduate Catalog 2006-2007 for <u>NSG 4430</u>, <u>Advanced Nursing Theory</u> and <u>NSG 4431</u>, <u>Advanced Nursing Preceptorship</u> are as follows:

NSG 4430 Advanced Nursing Theory (3)

Examines individuals and group responses to complex, multi-system stressors within the human environment. Explores complex multi-system processes. Emphasizes the nurse's role in diagnosing and treating individuals and groups in complex, multi-system stressors in acute care environments. *Prerequisites: Successful completion of all general studies requirements, NSG 3370, NSG 3309, NSG 3310, NSG 4405, NSG 4406, and NSG 4407. Co-requisite: NSG 4431.*

NSG 4431 Advanced Nursing Preceptorship (2-6)

Provides clinical learning opportunities for students to examine individual and group responses to complex, multi-system disease processes. Emphasizes diagnosing and treating individuals and groups in a variety of settings. Prerequisites: Successful completion of all general studies requirements, NSG 3370, NSG 3309, NSG 3310, NSG 4405, 4406, and 4407. Co-requisite: NSG 4430.

 Updated course descriptions for the Troy University, Undergraduate Catalog 2007-2008 for NSG 4430, Advanced Nursing Theory and NSG 4437, Advanced Nursing Preceptorship as approved in the BSN Faculty meeting on October 10, 2006 are as follows:

NSG 4430 Advanced Nursing Theory (3)

Examines individuals and group responses to complex, multi-system stressors within the human-environment interactive system. Emphasizes the nurse's role in diagnosing and treating individuals and groups with complex, multi-system stressors through the use of nursing concepts in various health care settings. The role of the nurse as a leader and manager is also examined. Prerequisites: Successful completion of all general studies courses, NSG 3370, NSG 3309, NSG 3310, NSG 4405, NSG 4406, and NSG 4407. Co-requisite: NSG 4431.

NSG 4431 Advanced Nursing Preceptorship (2-6)

Provides clinical learning opportunities for students to examine individual and group responses to complex, multi-system disease processes as well as leadership and management skills. Emphasizes the nurse's role in diagnosing and treating individuals and groups with complex, multi-system disease processes through the use of nursing concepts. Emphasizes the role of the nurse as a leader and manager. Prerequisites: Successful completion of all general studies courses, NSG 3370, NSG 3309, NSG 3310, NSG 4405, 4406, and 4407. Corequisite: NSG 4430.

Rationale for Updating Course Descriptions: These updated course descriptions
for the nursing courses (NSG 4430 and NSG 4431) in the BSN clinical nursing
sequence of the RN to BSN/MSN track will reflect the current trends in RN to BSN
education in Alabama and across the US with emphasis on leadership and
management skills for the nurse and nursing concepts that are applicable in the
various health care settings. RN to BSN programs no longer emphasize the acute
care setting.
