The proposed degree program will be offered with concentrations in Human Resource Management, Leadership and Organizational Effectiveness, and Healthcare Management. **Please resubmit the faculty roster listing the course names rather than just the abbreviation and course number; for instance, the reviewer has no clue what BUS 6610 means. Other questions from the roster:**

James A. Buford; what is SPHR under Other Qualifications and Experience?

Elizabeth L. Duncan; unless the course names indicate the relationship, how does her experience as D.C. Municipal Counsel, VA Counsel and EEO Counsel qualify her to teach the courses listed?

Franklin D. Gaillard; how does "professional IT consultant" qualify him to teach IS 6679?

Thomas F. Seebode; what is SPHR?

H. Lee Washington; holds an accounting degree but teaches management. How does "Entrepreneur . . . Fmr USMC internal auditor . . . Chair, County Rsrch Eval Cmte (Thomasville, GA) . . . qualify him to teach the two management courses?

Stephen C. Wingreen holds the Ph.D. in Bus Adm; what qualifies him to teach IS 6679?

We shall defer action on the proposal until we receive additional information.

Eugene Schmuckler; If MGT 6671 is management, please document his qualifications to teach the course with degrees in IOPsych.

We shall defer action on the proposal until we receive the additional information requested.
