Please consider this letter as the notification that Troy State University (TSU) is replacing the Professional MBA degree program with the Executive MBA degree program. Effective fall 2000, TSU will begin this transition from the PMBA to the EMBA.

The Professional MBA degree program contained ten (10) courses (9 required and 1 elective) with a comprehensive examination. The Executive MBA degree program contains twelve (12) courses (9 required and 3 elective concentration courses) with exit assessment drawn from a final comprehensive case examination in the capstone course and an applied research project. Both the final examination and the applied research project will be evaluated by a panel of faculty members. Both the PMBA and the EMBA degrees require a prerequisite survey of business courses.

Existing Professional MBA students will have the option of completing the PMBA degree program or transferring to the Executive MBA degree program.
