Thank you for three recent letters regarding change at your institution. Your letter of May 30, 2006, notified the Commission of your intent to add an International Hospitality Management concentration to the approved Master of Science in Management degree program and to offer this new concentration in the Florida Region beginning Fall 2006. Since both the degree program and the site are approved, we accept your notification and require no further information from you.

You wrote on June 5, 2006, with the following program changes:

1. The Master of Science in Post Secondary Education (MSPSE) degree program will be offered at the Fort Carson/Colorado Springs, Colorado site with a start date of August 1, 2006.
2. The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree program will be offered at the Holloman AFB, New Mexico site with a start date of August 1, 2006.
3. The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree program will be offered at the Malmstrom AFB, Montana site with a start date of August 1, 2006.
4. The General Business major with a concentration in Small Business and Entrepreneurship will be added to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration at the Atlanta, Georgia site with a start date of October 2006.

Since you are adding an approved degree program to an approved site in all four instances, we accept your notification and require no further information from you.
