Dear Jack:

Thank you for several recent letters regarding change at your institution:

1. You wrote on September 22, 2005, to notify the Commission of your intent to offer the Associate of Science in General Education and the Master of Business Administration degree programs, effective January 2005, at the Atlanta site.
2. Your letter of October 3, 2005, notified the Commission of your intent to offer the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree program at the Davis-Monthan AFB, Arizona campus and the Master of Public Administration at the Fort Benning, Georgia site effective January 2006.
3. Your letter of October 5, 2005, notified the Commission that you offered the MBA degree program at the Tampa, Florida site effective August 2005. The tardy reporting was due to an internal misrouting of approval on your campus.

Since these are approved programs to be offered at approved sites, we accept your notification and require no further information from you.

Thank you for your second letter of October 5, 2005 (received in our office on October 27, 2005), and the notification of delayed start dates for some programs:

You also defined some terms used in describing your relationship with an institution at an international site:

1. **Affiliation or Collaboration:** In a collaborative relationship, the University works with the partner institution to offer a Troy University degree. Troy University provides the curriculum, faculty, academic support, and the same program as offered at other regional sites. All courses are taught by Troy University certified and approved faculty members. The partner institution provides facilities and logistical support.
2. **Dual Degree:** In a dual degree relationship, students complete course requirements with Troy University as well as with the partner institution, and upon graduation, students receive two degrees—one from Troy University and one from the partner institution.
3. **International Articulation:** In an international articulation relationship, students transfer credits from another international institution, and the transferred course work is carefully examined by the appropriate college deans and/or committees for equivalency transfer as is done with institutions of the United States.

Thank you for this additional information; we shall add it to your file.

You wrote on November 10, 2005, to amend the start dates listed in your letter of October 5, 2005, for the Philadelphia, Pennsylvania site. The following programs will be offered effective January 2006:
